Specific needs - Summer 2016 and Fall 2016

- **Book and Magazine Promotion and Marketing:** The magazine and the editor's 2014 book, [*VOICE MALE: The Untold Story of the Profeminist Men's Movement*](#) benefit from marketing and promotion. The intern secures speaking engagements and assists in promoting subscriptions to the magazine. Work is underway for a second edition of the book to be published in Spring 2017.
- **Social media:** The magazine continues to enhance its social media presence and would benefit from an intern with interests and skills in promoting the publication's reach using social media.
- **Website:** While the magazine is both a print and online publication, we are particularly interested in an intern with skills who can maintain, update, and improve the site.
- **Writing:** Opportunities exist for some writing (including news shorts, book and film reviews, as well as promotional copy).
- **Office:** Database management, renewal letters, business emails and phone calls.
- **Research:** Two projects in development: a global anthology and an updated edition of the 2014 *Voice Male* anthology, provide opportunities for the intern to conduct and organize research on the current state of men's engagement in gender justice both domestically and globally.
